This letter is written to clarify a question about Biological Research Laboratory, 01:119:117, a one-semester course that accompanies the two-semester lecture sequence, General Biology I and II (01:119:115-116). The laboratory carries two credits, four hours of laboratory exercises and an 80-minute lecture each week. It is normally taken by students who require general biology, including biology majors.

The Division of Life Sciences, which requires a standard general biology course for all of its majors, including those anticipating a research career, accepts this one-semester course. They have determined that their course meets all requirements of a General Biology laboratory course. The Health Professions Office accepts this sequence for students anticipating application to post-graduate study in the health professions.
